Head Start and Early Head Start

Head Start is working hard getting ready for the 2024-2025 school year. New sun sails are being installed at two of the centers for the playgrounds, new mulch is being put down, and classroom floors are being cleaned and waxed. We are welcoming our new Center Director, Latora Forrester, and our new Family Services Specialist, Ahmad Paige, at our Eufaula Center. Wendy Cook, HR Director, has been fervently recruiting and interviewing for positions that are open and for substitute positions. The Early Head Start classes in Andalusia are still plugging along through the summer, and we are anxiously awaiting the go ahead from DHR to open our two Early Head Start classrooms in Florala. We have over 30 children who have applied for those 16 spots. Some of our Head Start teachers will be attending the MegaConference in Mobile to increase their teaching skills and to learn more about the latest resources available for educators and students. Our Pre-Service will be during the week of July 22 where our teachers will learn new techniques along with the new DHR requirements. We are incredibly excited about the improvements that we have in place for the next school year.

Wiregrass Transit Dothan and Enterprise



We offer a wide range of transportation services within the City of Dothan, Houston County, Dale County, and the City of Enterprise. Our service area is limited to these areas currently. Individuals residing outside of our service area that wish to use our services must arrange to be picked up and dropped off within the service area. The Dial-a-Ride is the most visible portion of our transportation system and the one most-used by the general public. There are some basic rules for the program:

- You must call at least one day in advance.
- First come, first serve.
- Service is dependent on the availability of seats and vehicles.
